#### LOCATION: Rabbit Barn

- JUDGING: The American Rabbit Breeders Association Standard of Perfection is used for judging. \*Follow age & weight guidelines from the ARBA Standard of Perfection when selecting lots for breeding classes.
- **RULES:** An animal CANNOT compete in both 4-H and FFA.

\*A rabbit can only be shown in Breeding OR Market classes, NOT both.

\*A rabbit **CAN** be dual entered in Fur class in addition to Breeding **OR** Market classes.

Classes may be COMBINED based on entries.

### **OPEN CLASS ENTRIES**

PRE-REGISTER: All Open Class animals must PRE-REGISTER by JULY 20. In order to earn PREMIUM

## **IDENTIFICATION/HEALTH**

- **IDENTIFICATION:** All rabbits entering the fairgrounds must be permanently tattooed for identification. All animals will be checked upon arrival. Any animal without proper identification will be required to leave the fairgrounds, & the animal will not be eligible for competition or premium. \*Proper identification outlined on pages 22-25.
- HEALTH CHECK: All caged rabbits will be examined by the superintendent and an official veterinarian.

## **ANIMAL ARRIVAL**

- CAGING: Caging is LIMITED. Therefore, caging is not required for Open Class rabbits. If Open Class caging is desired for entire Fair, contact superintendent for availability.
- ARRIVAL TIME: Open Class rabbits not being caged during the entire Fair may arrive 2 hours before show. They must be taken home IMMEDIATELY after Open Show ends.
- RELEASE TIME: Caged rabbits will be released no sooner than 6:00 PM on Sunday.
